



2nd Quarter Financial Results

We've once again ended the quarter with strong results in all areas. We are pleased to announce our 2nd quarter dividend at \$0.25 per share!

At the end of second quarter in 2018, our net income was \$1.5 Million; and at the end of second quarter in 2019, we've surpassed those figures by a significant 17.94 percent coming in at net income of \$1.8 Million. This is excellent news for stockholders.

A combination of strong deposits now at \$370 Million and increasing assets of \$439.2 Million along with loan growth at a remarkable 2.68 percent over first quarter, we are in a solid financial position.

Loan growth has continued to be a key driver for us in 2019 from \$354 Million at the end of Q1 to \$364 Million now at the end of Q2. Our business lending group continues to have a strong year with the first half of 2019's loan production in excess of \$74 Million. Executive Vice President, Chief Lending Officer Ron Blawusch has a very strong team of seasoned business lenders who continue to deliver results for us. The business lending team is made up of Larry Schwenn, Vince Hartman, Dave Robbins, Joe Schuch and Ron. We're confident our business lending team is the premier group of business lenders in the area.

Again, thank you for your continued confidence as we move into the second half of 2019. This has been a great year for the Bank of Sun Prairie.
